Tallon Griekspoor | Age: 28 | World No. 37 | Career-High No. 21 | 2025: 14-6 (Marrakech F) | Marrakech: 4-2 (2025 F)
> Earned personal-best 36 wins in 2023, won 1st ATP Tour title in Pune and achieved career-high No. 21 in November.

> Went 17-3 on home soil in 2023-24, highlighted by 2nd title at 2023 's-Hertogenbosch and rallying from a set down to defeat No. 8 Hurkacz en route to 2024 Rotterdam SF.

> Rallied from a set down for Rotterdam wins as WC over No. 13 Wawrinka in 2018, No. 11 Khachanov in 2019, No. 14 Karatsev in 2022, No. 17 A. Zverev in 2023 and for 's-Hertogenbosch win over No. 18 de Minaur in 2023 – earning first 5 of 15 career Top-20 wins on home soil.

> Went 8-0 in finals and 42-7 overall on ATP Challenger Tour in 2021, setting single-season record for most titles and ending season with 25 straight wins.

NOTE: Griekspoor seeks his 3rd ATP Tour title (2-1 in finals), first on clay, after capturing titles at 2023 Pune on hard courts and 2023 's-Hertogenbosch on grass. He would be fifth Top 40 player to win the title and fifth Dutchman to win tour-level titles on all three surfaces in Open Era. He is 7-1 vs. players ranked outside the Top 50 this season.

Luciano Darderi | Age: 23 | World No. 57 | Career-High No. 32 | 2025: 6-8 (Marrakech Final) | Marrakech: 4-0 (2025 final)

> Former Top 10 junior started 2024 season as No. 128, then broke into Top 100 in February, Top 50 in May and achieved career-high No. 32 in August.

> Captured his 1st ATP Tour title in Cordoba, defeating Bagnis in 3rd final between two qualifiers since the ATP Tour was established in 1990 and in his 3rd ATP Tour event of career.

> Also advanced to 2nd ATP Tour final in Marrakech and SFs at 2024 Houston (l. to Tiafoe) and 2024 Lyon (l. to Etcheverry).

> Owns 90-59 Challenger record (3-3 in finals), winning titles at 2023 Todi, 2023 Lima-2 and 2024 Perugia.

> Peaked at No. 8 in junior rankings in February 2020 after earning 3 singles and 3 doubles titles to start the season.

> Born in Argentina, started playing tennis at age 4 with his father Luciano Enrique, a former tennis player and current coach.

NOTE: Darderi looks for his 2nd ATP Tour title after winning 2024 Cordoba as Q and aims to become 2nd Italian in a row to win Marrakech. 23-year-old would join Fognini (8), Berrettini (6) and Cecchinato (3) as only active Italian men to own multiple ATP Tour titles on clay and seeks 2nd Top 50 win of 2025 (1-4, d. No. 40 Martinez in Miami 1R).
