Swiatek Leads 5-1

Iga Swiatek | Age: 24 | WTA World No. 2 | Career-High No. 1 (Apr 2022) | 2025: 62-17 (3 titles) | Career: 314-76 (25 titles)

- > Won three singles titles in 2025, including her first Wimbledon title, Cincinnati and Seoul; finished at World No.2 for the second straight season
- > Posted 62 match-wins in 2025, becoming the first player to achieve four consecutive 60-win seasons at Tour level since Martina Hingis (1997-2001) and Lindsay Davenport (1998-2001)
- > Owns 25 career singles trophies including six Grand Slam titles, one WTA Finals trophy, eleven WTA 1000 titles, six WTA 500 titles and one WTA 250 title
- > Reached PIF World No.1 ranking in April 2022 and has spent a total of 125 weeks at the top spot (seventh-most of all time)
- > Became the first Polish player in history to win a Grand Slam title at Roland Garros 2020; she also became the lowest ranked (No.54) Roland Garros champion in history
- > In women’s doubles reached the final at Roland Garros in 2021 (w/Mattek-Sands) and in mixed doubles reached the US Open final in 2025 (w/Ruud)



NOTE: Holds a 15-3 singles record at United Cup, with her only singles losses at the event coming to No. 3-ranked Americans Coco Gauff (in 2025 and 2026) and Jessica Pegula (in 2023). Swiatek is 11-11 (.500) vs. Top 20 players on hard court since the start of 2025.

Belinda Bencic | Age: 28 | WTA World No. 11 | Career-High No. 4 (Feb 2020) | 2025: 37-17 (2 titles) | Career: 285-179 (10 titles)
 > Ten time WTA Tour singles champion, winning her tenth title near the end of 2025 at Tokyo; she has also reached 10 additional WTA Tour singles finals
 > Has won two WTA Tour doubles titles, both in 2015 (Prague with Siniakova, and Washington DC with Mladenovic)
 > During 2025, skyrocketed from No.421 at the start of January to No.11 in the year-end ranking, in her first full season after maternity leave; went 2-0 in Tour finals, winning titles at WTA 500 events at Abu Dhabi and Tokyo, and also reached her second career Grand Slam SF at Wimbledon
 > Was voted WTA Comeback Player of the Year 2025
 > Played United Cup in 2023 (1-1 in singles, 1-0 in doubles) and 2025 (1-1 in both singles and doubles)
 > Won two medals for Switzerland at the 2021 Olympics in Tokyo, finishing as singles gold medalist (d. Vondrousova in final) and the doubles silver medalist (w/Golubic, I. Krejciakova/Siniakova in final)

NOTE: Bencic holds a 6-7 career record vs. players ranked inside the Top 2 at the time of their meeting. Her most recent win over a Top 2 player came at the 2019 US Open, when she defeated defending champion and World No.1 Naomi Osaka en route to her first Grand Slam semifinal. Bencic is 0-4 vs. Top 2 players since then, with three of those losses coming to Swiatek, including at the 2023 United Cup.

Hubert Hurkacz (POL) vs Stan Wawrinka (SUI) **Hurkacz Leads 1-0**

Hubert Hurkacz | Age: 28 | ATP World No. 83 | Career-High No. 6 | 2025: 15-11 (Geneva Final) | Career: 229-154 (8 Titles)
 > Top Polish men's player in history ended 2021 and 2023 at year-end career-high No. 9 after Nitto ATP Finals appearances and reached career-high No. 6 in August 2024.
 > Entered 2021 Wimbledon on 6-match losing streak, then reached 1st Grand Slam SF by defeating 8-time champion Federer 6-3 7-6(4) 6-0 in final singles match of Swiss' career.
 > Upset 5 seeds to win 2021 ATP Masters 1000 Miami title and saved a championship point to win 2023 ATP Masters 1000 Shanghai after losing in the 2022 ATP Masters 1000 Montreal final.
 > Also advanced to ATP Masters 1000 SFs at 2021 Paris, 2022 Miami and 2023 Cincinnati and captured ATP Masters 1000 doubles titles at 2020 Paris w/Auger-Aliassime and 2022 Miami w/Isner.
 > Defeated No. 1 Medvedev 6-1 6-4 in 63 minutes to win 5th ATP Tour singles title in 5th final at 2022 Halle (now 8-4 in finals).

NOTE: Hurkacz owns 10-8 singles record in United Cup, including 3-1 this year, but is 0-2 in United Cup finals after losing in 3 sets to Zverev in 2024 (held 2 championship points) and Fritz last year. 28-year-old is 16-0 vs. players ranked outside Top 100 since losing to No. 123 Draper in 2023 US Open 2R.

Stan Wawrinka | Age: 40 | ATP World No. 156 | Career-High No. 3 | 2025: 4-13 (4x 2R) | Career: 583-379 (16 Titles)
 > Achieved career-high No. 3 in 2014 and ended 2014-16 at No. 4 before undergoing 2 left knee surgeries in 2017 and 2 left foot surgeries in 2021.
 > Boasts 5 wins over World No. 1 at Grand Slams, including finals of 2014 Australian Open (d. Nadal), 2015 Roland Garros (d. Djokovic) and 2016 US Open (d. Djokovic).
 > One of 3 players to defeat Djokovic, Federer, Murray and Nadal at Grand Slams (also Berdych, Tsonga).
 > Owns 16 singles titles with 11 straight wins in finals from 2014-16, defeating fellow Swiss Federer for lone ATP Masters 1000 title at 2014 Monte-Carlo.
 > Won 2008 Beijing Olympics doubles gold medal w/Federer and helped Switzerland capture 2014 Davis Cup.

NOTE: Wawrinka is playing in the final of a national team competition for the second time in career, 12 years after winning 2014 Davis Cup with Switzerland (d. France 3-1). He is 2-4 at United Cup in singles, including 1-3 this year (d. Rinderknech) and aims to record multiple wins in one ATP Tour event for 1st time since run to 2024 Stockholm SF.
