21 Countries: Tied with 1987 for most countries represented in US Open 3R during Open Era
Spain 4, Australia 3, USA 3, Germany 2, Italy 2, Russia 2, Switzerland 2, Argentina 1, Belgium 1, Bulgaria 1, Canada 1, Croatia 1, France 1, Georgia 1, Great Britain 1, Japan 1, Kazakhstan 1, Poland 1, Serbia 1, Slovenia 1, South Korea 1

15 Seeds: Fewest seeds in US Open 3R since tournament went from 16 to 32 seeds in 2001
Fewest seeds in Grand Slam 3R since 2004 Roland Garros (14) -- last Slam won by unseeded player (Gaston Gaudio)
Only one of 16 matches in 3R will be between seeds: [14] John Isner vs. [22] Marin Cilic
