ATP HEAD2HEAD: SINGLES QUARTER-FINAL

[WC] Filip Misolic (AUT) vs Dusan Lajovic (SRB)

First Meeting

Filip Misolic | Age: 20 | World No. 205 | Career-High No. 194 | 2022: 2-0 (Kitzbuhel QF) | Kitzbuhel: 2-0 (2022 QF)
> Broke into Top 200 and achieved career-high No. 194 at age 20 in July 2022.
> Defeated Dutra da Silva and Andujar in ATP Tour main draw debut to reach 2022 Kitzbuhel QF as WC.
> Qualified and posted 7 wins en route to 1st Challenger SF, final and title at 2022 Zagreb.
> Owns 6-1 record in ITF World Tennis Tour finals, most recently winning 2022 Porec title.
> Peaked at No. 63 on ITF Junior Circuit with 81-56 record, but never played at a Grand Slam event in juniors.

NOTE: ATP Tour debutant Misolic is in QF after losing in Q1 at Wimbledon (l. to Jung) and Gstaad (l. to Hanfmann).

Dusan Lajovic | Age: 32 | World No. 80 | Career-High No. 23 | 2022: 10-19 (Kitzbuhel QF) | Kitzbuhel: 11-6 ('16 SF)
> Achieved career-high No. 23 after defeating future World No. 1 Medvedev to reach 1st ATP Tour singles final at 2019 ATP Masters 1000 Monte Carlo.
> Entered Monte Carlo as World No. 48 and became lowest-ranked finalist at that event since No. 53 Aranzi in 2001.
> Won 1st ATP Tour singles title at 2019 Umag, doubles title at 2015 Istanbul w/Albot and team title at 2020 ATP Cup as member of Team Serbia.
> Advanced to Grand Slam 4R for 1st time at 2014 Roland Garros, losing to 14-time champion Nadal.
> Qualified 12 times at ATP Masters 1000 events, including en route to 2018 Madrid QF.

NOTE: Lajovic is in 5th Kitzbuhel QF in 7 main draw appearances (2015 QF, 2016 SF, 2017 QF, 2018 QF, 2022 QF).

A. Ramos-Vinolas | Age: 34 | World No. 52 | Career-High No. 17 | 2022: 19-17 (Cordoba Title) | Kitzbuhel: 8-7 ('19 F)
> Achieved career-high No. 17 in 2017 and has finished each of last 11 seasons in Top 100 (2011-21).
> Played in 11 finals on ATP Tour, winning clay-court titles at 2016 Bastad, 2019 Gstaad, 2021 Estoril and 2022 Cordoba.
> Advanced to 3R, 4R and QF of a Grand Slam for 1st time at 2016 Roland Garros.
> Reached QF, SF and final of an ATP Masters 1000 event for 1st time at 2017 Monte Carlo, earning biggest career win over No. 1 Murray in 3R from 0-4 down in 3rd set.
> Defeated defending champion and World No. 3 Federer in 2015 ATP Masters 1000 Shanghai 2R for 1st win in 16 tries vs. Top 10.

NOTE: Ramos-Vinolas is 11-14 in ATP Tour SFs (10-13 on clay). Bautista Agut is 20-21 in tour-level SFs (2-7 clay).

Roberto Bautista Agut | Age: 34 | World No. 20 | Career-High No. 9 | '22: 25-11 (Doha Title) | Kitzbuhel: 2-1 ('22 SF)
> Captured 10 ATP Tour titles, achieved career-high No. 9 in 2019 and earned 300th win in 2020 (d. Sandgren in US Open 1R).
> Reached 1st Grand Slam SF at 2019 Wimbledon and 1st Grand Slam QF at 2019 Australian Open after entering season with 0-9 record in Grand Slam 4R.
> Defeated No. 1 Djokovic in 2016 ATP Masters 1000 Shanghai SF, 2019 Doha SF and 2019 ATP Masters 1000 Miami 4R, as well as No. 1 Medvedev in 2022 Mallorca QF.
> Went 4-1 at 2022 ATP Cup and 6-0 at 2020 ATP Cup to lead Spain to finals after helping Spain win 2019 Davis Cup.
> Played football for Villarreal C.F. until he was 14 years old.

NOTE: Bautista Agut hopes to join 2019 finalist Ramos-Vinolas as 19th Spaniard to reach Kitzbuhel final in Open Era.

Yannick Hanfmann | Age: 30 | World No. 140 | Career-High No. 92 | 2022: 7-5 (Kitzbuhel SF) | Kitzbuhel: 7-3 ('20 F)
> Hearing-impaired player broke into Top 100 in 2018 and achieved career-high No. 92 in 2021.
> Qualified en route to 1st ATP Tour final at 2017 Gstaad and 2nd final at 2020 Kitzbuhel.
> Earned biggest win of career over No. 9 Monfils at 2020 Hamburg, where he accepted main draw WC instead of playing qualifying at Roland Garros.
> Posted 1st Grand Slam main draw win in 7th try at 2022 Australian Open as Q (d. Kokkinakis).
> Captured 6 Challenger titles after playing for University of Southern California (2012-15), where he helped Trojans win 2 NCAA national titles.

NOTE: Hanfmann seeks 3rd ATP final while outside Top 100 (No. 170 at 2017 Gstaad, No. 118 at 2020 Kitzbuhel).
