Lorenzo Musetti | Age: 23 | World No. 7 | Career-High No. 6 | Career: 177-133 (2 Titles) | Hong Kong: 2-2 (2025 QF)
> Former World No. 1 junior broke into Top 20 in January 2023 and Top 10 in May 2025, earning career-high No. 6 in June 2025 after advancing to Roland Garros SF.

> Defeated 19-year-old Alcaraz in 2022 Hamburg final at age 20, marking youngest ATP Tour final since 2005 Bastad (19-year-old Nadal d. 19-year-old Berdych) and did not drop a set en route to 2nd title at 2022 Naples.

> Upset Tokyo gold medallist Zverev en route to bronze medal at 2024 Paris Olympics, earning 1st Olympic singles medal for Team Italy in tennis since 1924.

> Earned personal-best 45 wins in 2025, reaching 1st ATP Masters 1000 final in Monte-Carlo and advancing to SFs of Madrid and Rome to become first Italian to reach all 3 clay ATP Masters 1000 and Roland Garros SFs in one season.

> At 2023 Monte-Carlo, earned 1st 6-0 6-0 victory at ATP Masters 1000 level since 2016 over Nardi in 2R before upsetting No. 1 Djokovic in 3R for biggest win of career to reach 2nd ATP Masters 1000 QF.

> Reached 2018 US Open boys' singles final, won 2019 Australian Open boys' singles title and defeated Wawrinka at 2020 ATP Masters 1000 Rome to become 1st player born in 2002 to win an ATP Tour match.

NOTE: Musetti looks for his 42nd tour-level quarter-final, 19th on hard courts, to reach back-to-back quarter-finals in Hong Kong after advancing to the stage last year (I. Munar). He is a No. 1 seed at an ATP Tour event for the seventh time, including twice last year (Chengdu - Final, Brussels - QF).

Tomas Martin Etcheverry | Age: 26 | World No. 57 | Career-High No. 27 | Career: 92-102 (3 Finals) | Hong Kong: 1-0 ('26 2R)
> Former World No. 12 junior broke into Top 200 in June 2021 and Top 100 in April 2022, achieving career-high No. 27 in February 2024.

> At 2023 Roland Garros, earned 1st two Top 20 wins of career over No. 19 de Minaur in 2R and No. 16 Coric in 3R and reached the quarter-finals without dropping a set.

> Defeated clay-court champions Fognini, F. Cerundolo, Lajovic and Baez en route to 1st ATP Tour final at Santiago and J. Cerundolo and Garin en route to 2nd ATP Tour final at 2023 Houston.

> Earned personal-best 31 wins in 2024, highlighted by Lyon final, where he held 1 MP against Mpetshi Perricard.

> Posted Challenger records of 49-19 in 2021 and 41-16 in 2022, highlighted by clay-court titles at 2021 Perugia, 2021 Trieste and 2022 Concepcion-2.

NOTE: Etcheverry is 0-16 vs. Top 10, aiming to record the biggest win of career. He seeks 19th tour-level quarter-final, fifth on hard courts, to become the second Argentine men's quarter-finalist in event history after Chela in 2002.

Coleman Wong | Age: 21 | World No. 150 | Career-High No. 128 | Career: 19-15 (2x 3R) | Hong Kong: 1-2 (2026 2R)
> Former World No. 11 junior broke into Top 500 in September 2023, Top 200 in April 2024 and achieved career-high No. 128 in September 2024.

> Qualified at 2025 US Open to become 1st man playing for Hong Kong to feature in Grand Slam main draw in Open Era and first since Ip and Tsai at 1954 Wimbledon, and first man from Hong Kong to reach Grand Slam 3R.

> Defeated No. 14 Shelton for biggest win of career to advance to 2025 ATP Masters 1000 Miami 3R.

> Owns 62-49 Challenger record (0-5 in finals), reaching finals at 2023 Shenzhen (Luohu), 2023 Playford, 2024 New Delhi, 2024 Lincoln and 2025 Seoul.

> Became Hong Kong's second ever junior Grand Slam winner in any discipline (Patricia Hy - 1983 Wimbledon girls' doubles), winning boys' doubles titles at 2021 US Open w/Westphal and 2022 Australian Open w/Kuzuhara.

NOTE: Wong defeated Navone in 1R to become 1st man representing Hong Kong to earn a main draw win in tournament history. 21-year-old seeks third Top 50 win (2-5), after wins over No. 14 Shelton at 2025 ATP Masters 1000 Miami and No. 42 Mpetshi Perricard at 2025 ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati, to reach his 1st ATP Tour QF.

Gabriel Diallo | Age: 24 | World No. 40 | Career-High No. 33 | Career: 41-39 (1 Title) | Hong Kong: 2-1 (2025-26 2R)

> Broke into Top 100 in October 2024 and Top 50 in June 2025, achieving career-high No. 33 in August 2025, after capturing his 1st ATP Tour title in 's-Hertogenbosch, becoming 1st Canadian man to win grass-court title since 1993.

> Saved 3 MPs to defeat No. 16 Dimitrov for biggest win of career and advance to 1st ATP Masters 1000 QF at 2025 Madrid as LL, before saving 2 MPs vs. Thompson en route to 's-Hertogenbosch title.

> Earned 1st ATP Tour win by defeating No. 21 Evans at 2023 ATP Masters 1000 Toronto 1R as WC and reached 1st ATP Tour QF, SF and final at 2024 Almaty.

> Owns 65-37 Challenger record (3-1 in finals), winning 1st title at 2022 Granby as No. 519-ranked WC.

> Played for the University of Kentucky, making the quarter-final round at 2022 NCAA Singles Championships before turning pro at the end of 2022.

NOTE: Diallo aims to advance to his 5th ATP Tour QF (2-2), second on hard courts after his run to 2024 Almaty final. He would be the third Canadian quarter-finalist in event history after Connell in 1990 and Lareau in 1997-98.

Andrey Rublev | Age: 28 | World No. 16 | Career-High No. 5 | Career: 369-209 (17 Titles) | Hong Kong: 4-1 ('24 Title)

> Former No. 1 junior broke into Top 20 in January 2020, Top 10 in October 2020 and Top 5 in September 2021.

> Rallied from a set down in both SF (d. Fritz) and final (d. Rune) at 2023 Monte-Carlo to capture 1st ATP Masters 1000 title and defeated two-time defending champion No. 3 Alcaraz en route to 2nd title at 2024 Madrid.

> Defeated No. 3 Nadal at 2021 Monte-Carlo, No. 2 Medvedev at 2021 Cincinnati and No. 1 Sinner at 2024 Montreal en route to ATP Masters 1000 finals and beat No. 1 Djokovic for 11th of 17 ATP Tour titles at 2022 Belgrade.

> Led tour with 5 titles in 2020, tied for tour-lead with 41 victories in 2020, and won 23 matches and 4 titles in a row at ATP 500 events from 2020-21.

> Ten-time Grand Slam quarter-finalist reached 2022 Nitto ATP Finals SF and won gold medal in All-ROC mixed doubles final at 2020 Tokyo Olympics w/Pavlyuchenkova (held in 2021).

> Went 9-1 in singles and 4-1 in doubles at team events during 2021 season, sweeping titles at ATP Cup, Laver Cup and Davis Cup.

NOTE: Rublev is one of two former champions in the draw (also Muller) and seeks 83rd tour-level quarter-final, 61st on hard courts and first since ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati in August. He owns a 6-1 record vs. Chinese players in his career, lone loss to Buyunchaokete in 2024 Beijing QF.

Wu Yibing | Age: 26 | World No. 179 | Career-High No. 54 | Career: 27-32 (1 Title) | Hong Kong: 1-0 (2026 2R)
> Rose from No. 1,869 in March 2022 to No. 54 in May 2023 after missing March 2019-January 2022 due to injuries.
> Saved 4 championship points vs. Isner at 2023 Dallas following SF win over No. 8 Fritz, becoming 1st Chinese man to win an ATP Tour title, reach an ATP Tour final and earn a Top-10 win.
> Qualified at 2022 US Open and became 1st Chinese man to reach US Open 3R in tournament history (since 1881), falling to World No. 1 Medvedev, before defeating No. 18 Medvedev en route to 2025 Hangzhou SF.
> Posted 40-7 record in main draw and qualifying matches across all levels in 2022, winning 3 ATP Challenger Tour titles and an ITF World Tennis Tour title in Orange Park, FL, USA.
> Swept 2017 US Open boys' singles title and boys' doubles title w/Hsu to become World No. 1 junior, then won Shanghai Challenger title a week later as 496th-ranked WC.

NOTE: Wu aims to reach his 4th ATP Tour QF (2-1) after 2023 Dallas, 2023 Geneva and 2025 Hangzhou. 26-year-old is 2-9 vs. Top 20 in his career, earning wins over No. 8 Fritz at 2023 Dallas and No. 18 Hangzhou QF last year. With a win, he would jump to No. 157 on [PIF ATP Live Rankings](#) after being ranked outside Top 400 in May.
