ATP HEAD2HEAD: SEMI-FINAL SINGLES MATCHES

NOTE: All-Top 4 seeds are in the semi-final of a tour-level event for the first time in 2022 and first time since 2021 ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati (Medvedev, Rublev, Tsitsipas, A. Zverev). First time it has happened in Los Cabos tournament history and first time at an ATP250 event since 2017 's-Hertogenbosch (Cilic, Karlovic, Muller, A. Zverev).

Medvedev Leads 1-0

Daniil Medvedev | Age: 26 | World No. 1 (Career-High) | 2022: 29-10 (3 Finals) | Los Cabos: 2-0 (2022 SF)

> Achieved career-high No. 1 in February 2022, becoming tallest World No. 1 in history at 1.98m (6'6") and 1st World No. 1 other than Djokovic, Nadal, Federer and Murray since Roddick in February 2004.

> Four-time Grand Slam finalist denied No. 1 Djokovic calendar Grand Slam by defeating him for 2021 US Open title.

> Beat No. 1 Djokovic, No. 2 Nadal and No. 3 Thiem en route to 2020 Nitto ATP Finals title, becoming 1st player to sweep Top 3 in tournament history and anywhere on ATP Tour since 2007 Madrid (Nalbandian).

> Earned 20 straight wins from 2020-21 (12 vs. Top 10), led ATP Tour with 63 victories in 2021, and captured team titles at 2021 ATP Cup, Laver Cup and Davis Cup.

> Won 12 of his 13 singles titles on hard courts (6 indoor, 6 outdoor), including ATP Masters 1000 championships at 2019 Cincinnati, 2019 Shanghai, 2020 Paris and 2021 Toronto.

NOTE: Medvedev seeks 4th tour-level final of the year (0-3) and 26th in his career (13-12). Reaching Los Cabos final would secure him the World No. 1 ranking until after 2022 US Open.

Miomir Kecmanovic | Age: 22 | World No. 38 | Career-High No. 30 | 2022: 29-15 (2 times in SF) | Los Cabos: 2-0 (2022 SF)

> Broke into Top 40 after winning 1st ATP Tour title at 2020 Kitzbuhel and achieved career-high No. 30 in June 2022.

> Went 2-11 to end 2021 and 25-11 to begin 2022, reaching Grand Slam 3R and 4R for 1st time at 2022 Australian Open.

> Advanced to ATP Masters 1000 QFs at 2019 Indian Wells as LL, 2022 Indian Wells and 2022 Miami, equaling biggest win of career in 2022 Indian Wells 4R vs. No. 6 Berrettini.

> Beat Ruud and Davidovich Fokina to reach 2019 Intesa Sanpaolo Next Gen ATP Finals SF (l. to eventual champion Sinner).

> Defeated Tsitsipas in 3rd-set TB to win 2015 Orange Bowl junior title, then ended 2016 as World No. 1 junior ahead of No. 2 Tsitsipas.

NOTE: Kecmanovic seeks biggest career win over World No. 1 Medvedev. He is 0-2 vs. World No. 1 players (l. to Djokovic at 2021-22 Belgrade), 0-6 vs. Top 5 players and 3-10 vs. Top 10 players (2-4 in 2022). He seeks 3rd ATP Tour final after 2019 Antalya (l. to Sonego) and 2020 Kitzbuhel (d. Hanfmann).

Cameron Norrie | Age: 26 | World No. 12 | Career-High No. 10 | 2022: 34-16 (2 Titles) | Los Cabos: 10-2 (2021 Title)

> Achieved career-high No. 10 in April 2022, joining Henman, Murray and Rusedski as 4th Brit to break into Top 10.

> Earned 52 wins in 2021 after entering season with 51 career wins, becoming 1st Brit to win ATP Masters 1000 Indian Wells title in 46-year tournament history.

> Won 1st of 4 ATP Tour titles at 2021 Los Cabos following runner-up finishes at 2019 Auckland as WC, 2021 Estoril, 2021 Lyon and 2021 London/Queen's Club.

> Posted 14 straight wins in North America from 2021-22, including upset of No. 4 Tsitsipas in 2022 Acapulco SF to equal biggest win of career.

> Born in South Africa to a Scottish father and Welsh mother, grew up in New Zealand, became No. 1 collegiate player in USA at Texas Christian University, and has represented Great Britain since 2013.

NOTE: Norrie became the first player to win 10 matches at the event in tournament history after his quarter-final win over Albot. He seeks to become the first player to make two Los Cabos finals after winning 1st ATP Tour title here in 2021. Norrie is 4-24 vs. Top 10 players, 1-6 in 2022 (d. No. 4 Tsitsipas in Acapulco SF).

Felix Auger-Aliassime | Age: 21 | World No. 9 (Career-High) | 2022: 32-17 (Rotterdam Title) | Los Cabos: 2-0 (2022 SF)

> Achieved career-high No. 9 after helping Canada win 2022 ATP Cup title, defeating No. 3 A. Zverev along the way for biggest win of career.

> Defeated fellow Top-10 players Rublev and Tsitsipas at 2022 Rotterdam for 1st ATP Tour title in 9th final.

> At 2021 US Open, became 1st Canadian men's singles semi-finalist in tournament history (since 1881).

> Also advanced to Grand Slam QFs at 2021 Wimbledon and 2022 Australian Open.

> As an 18-year-old in 2019, became youngest Top-25 player since Hewitt, 18, in 1999; youngest ATP 500 finalist in series history at Rio de Janeiro (since 2009); and youngest semi-finalist in Miami tournament history (since 1985).

NOTE: Auger-Aliassime seeks 11th ATP Tour final (1-9), 3rd of 2022, after making the finals of 2022 Rotterdam (d. Tsitsipas) and 2022 Marseille (l. to Rublev), both indoor hard-court events.
