### MEN'S DOUBLES SEMI-FINALS

#### LOUIS ARMSTRONG STADIUM

#### **DAY 11 FAST FACTS**

- In their 31st Grand Slam event as a team, **Juan Sebastian Cabal** and **Robert Farah** won Wimbledon to become the first Colombian Grand Slam men's doubles champions. Cabal is the only partner Farah has had at Grand Slams.
- One day after winning Wimbledon, Cabal and Farah became the first Colombians ranked No. 1 in doubles or singles.
- Cabal and Farah lost to eventual champions Mike Bryan and Jack Sock in the 2018 US Open semi-finals.
- Jamie Murray and Neal Skupski are trying to reach their first tour-level final in seven events as a team. They won
  the title in their team debut at the Phoenix, USA Challenger in March before becoming a full-time team in June.
- Murray has won a US Open title in 3 straight seasons (2016 men's doubles w/Soares, 2017 mixed doubles w/Hingis and 2018 mixed doubles w/Mattek-Sands). He's reached both the men's and mixed doubles semi-finals in 2019.
- Playing with other doubles partners, Murray is 7-5 and Skupski is 0-1 against Cabal/Farah.
- Both Brits are part of a tennis family. Murray's younger brother Andy and Skupski's older brother Ken play on tour.
- In their second Grand Slam event as a team, **Kevin Krawietz** and **Andreas Mies** won Roland Garros to become the first All-German Grand Slam men's doubles champions of the Open Era (d. **Jeremy Chardy/Fabrice Martin**).
- Krawietz and Mies lost 8 of their 10 matches between the Roland Garros final and the US Open first round.
- The Germans went 46-9 on the ATP Challenger Tour from August 2017 through May 2019 with 8 titles in 10 finals.
- Marcel Granollers and Horacio Zeballos are 9-0 as a team. Though the Spaniard and Argentine are undefeated, Granollers and another South American player, Pablo Cuevas, lost to Krawietz and Mies in 2018 Wimbledon 2R.
- Granollers owns 7 titles in his team debut with a partner, including 2019 ATP Masters 1000 Montreal with Zeballos.
