Raphael Collignon | Age: 23 | World No. 84 | Career-High No. 81 | 2025: 1-5 (Marrakech 2R) | Umag: 0-0 (Debut)
 > Broke into Top 100 in February 2025 and achieved career-high No. 81 in April after posting 1st ATP Tour win over former-World No. 9 Fognini in Marrakech 1R.
 > Made his tour-level debut in 2024 Davis Cup Finals Group Stage, losing to van de Zandschulp and Fonseca.
 > Defeated No. 84 van de Zandschulp to win 1st Challenger title at 2024 Luedenscheid and No. 97 Coric en route to 2nd title at Lyon (Décines-Charpieu).
 > Coached by Belgium's Davis Cup captain and former World No. 38 Steve Darcis.
 > Injured his thumb in Hamburg, a week before 2025 Roland Garros, to delay his Grand Slam main draw debut, before playing in his 1st Grand Slam main draw at 2025 Wimbledon (l. to Cilic).

NOTE: Collignon earned lone ATP Tour win of career by defeating Fognini in Marrakech in April. He now looks for biggest win of career after defeating No. 84 van de Zandschulp to win 1st Challenger title at 2024 Luedenscheid.

Vit Kopriva | Age: 28 | World No. 83 | Career-High No. 78 | 2025: 6-6 (Marrakech QF) | Umag: 0-0 (Debut)
 > Earned 1st ranking point at age 18 in 2015, broke into Top 500 in 2016, Top 200 in 2021 and Top 100 in April 2025, achieved career-high No. 78 in June 2025 after advancing to ATP Masters 1000 Rome 3R as Q.
 > Advanced to 2021 Gstaad SF as 249th-ranked Q, joining 2021 Cordoba champion J. Cerundolo as 2nd player since May 2012 to reach SF in his ATP Tour main draw debut.
 > Defeated No. 10 Shapovalov in 2021 Gstaad 2R to become lowest-ranked player to earn Top-10 win since No. 698 Kokkinakis beat No. 6 Raonic at 2017 London/Queen's Club.
 > Owns 140-101 Challenger record (6-3 in finals), capturing titles at 2022 Prostějov, 2023 Verona, 2023 Tulln, 2024 Szczecin, 2024 Lima-2 and 2025 Naples.
 > Former Top-75 junior earned boys' singles wins over future Top-10 ATP players de Minaur and Ruud.

NOTE: Kopriva earned all 6 of his 2025 tour-level wins on clay, highlighted by run to ATP Masters 1000 Rome 3R as Q in May. The Czech No. 4 is 4-2 in tour-level opening rounds in 2025, after going 0-7 in 2024.

[WC] Matej Dodig (CRO) vs Francesco Passaro (ITA)

First Meeting

Matej Dodig | Age: 20 | World No. 246 (Career-High) | 2025: 0-1 (Davis Cup Qualifier) | Umag: 1-1 (2024 2R)
 > Earned first ranking points in March 2023 and broke into Top 500 in November 2023 and Top 300 in July 2024, reaching career-high No. 246 in July 2025.
 > Made his ATP Tour debut at 2024 Umag as a WC and earned first win against Couacaud in 1R.
 > Owns a 28-29 Challenger record, capturing first title in first final at 2025 Trieste as Q.
 > Earned biggest win of career over No. 114 Svrčina at 2025 Trieste CH.
 > Peaked at a career-high ITF world junior ranking of No. 30 in January 2023.

NOTE: Dodig, who turned 20 yesterday, made his ATP Tour debut at this event last year and earned 1st ATP Tour win against qualifier Couacaud in 1R (l. to F. Cerundolo in 2R). He looks to record 2nd ATP Tour win of career, having captured his 1st Challenger title at Trieste earlier this month as qualifier.

Francesco Passaro | Age: 24 | World No. 131 | Career-High No. 89 | 2025: 4-5 (Rome 3R) | Umag: 0-0 (Debut)
 > In 2022, broke into Top 500 in March, Top 200 in July and qualified for 2022 Next Gen ATP Finals, before breaking into Top 100 in January 2025 and achieving career-high No. 89 in February.
 > Made Grand Slam main draw debut at 2025 Australian Open as LL, defeating No. 10 Dimitrov in 1R via RET for biggest win of his career and defeated No. 15 Dimitrov en route to 2025 ATP Masters 1000 Rome 3R.
 > Saved 2 MPs vs. Rinderknech en route to 3R of 2024 ATP Masters 1000 Rome and earned wins over countrymen Sonego and Musetti to capture his 2nd Challenger title in Turin in back-to-back weeks.
 > Advanced to 8 of his 9 Challenger finals on Italian clay, including titles at 2022 Trieste, 2024 Turin and 2024 Genoa.
 > Defeated Zhang for both 1st Challenger title at 2022 Trieste and 1st ATP Tour win at 2022 Florence.



NOTE: 7 of Passaro's 10 tour-level wins have been on clay, highlighted by back-to-back runs to ATP Masters 1000 Rome 3R in 2024-25. The Italian earned biggest win of career in Australian Open 1R in January over No. 10 Dimitrov via RET.
