ATP HEAD2HEAD: SUNDAY CHAMPIONSHIP MATCHES

Final Tidbits:

- Two of the young stars on the ATP Tour battle it out for the first time and both players are former participants in the Next Gen ATP Finals in Milan. Humbert went 1-2 last year in his debut and de Minaur is a two-time finalist in 2018-19.
- This is the first ATP Tour final by an Aussie this season while Frenchmen are 3-2 in finals with Gael Monfils (Montpellier, Rotterdam) and Humbert (Auckland) lifting trophies.
- Humbert is one of three left-handers to win titles this season: Rafael Nadal (2) and Jiri Vesely (1).
- No. 8 seeds are 2-2 in finals this season while unseeded players are 5-12 in finals.

- No. 3 Frenchman is appearing in his 2nd career ATP Tour final after saving 4 MPs in his SF win over Evans. Also posted wins over [WC] Coppejans, [2] Carreno Busta and [Q] Harris. Last year lost in SF (l. to eventual champ Murray).
- He is 4th Frenchman to reach the Antwerp final after 2016 champion Gasquet, 2017 champion Tsonga and 2018 finalist Monfils.
- Beat countryman Paire for 1st ATP Tour title at Auckland. First French champion in 65-year tournament history.
- Last week, lost to eventual champion Rublev in St. Petersburg 2R.

Bopanna/Middelkoop Summary | Tour Debut: Antwerp (this week) | 3-0 team record | First Final Together

- The Indian / Dutch duo have beaten two seeds en route to the final in their first tournament together, upsetting No. 4 Murray/N. Skupski in 1R and No. 5 Gille/Vliegen in SF. They have dropped two sets so far (6-2).
- Bopanna is ranked No. 37 (Career-high No. 3) and is 19-27 in finals. His last title came in January in Doha (w/Koolhof).
- Middelkoop is ranked No. 50 (Career-high No. 30) and he is appearing in his 21st ATP Tour final (9-11), the second in as many weeks. Last week was runner-up in St. Petersburg (w/Demoliner) and his last title came in Cordoba (w/Demoliner) in February.

Peers/Venus Summary | Tour Debut: 2020 Auckland | 20-8 career team record | 2-0 in Finals Together

- The Aussie / Kiwi pairing have not dropped a set (6-0) en route to their third final of the season.
- Peers and Venus began playing together this season and they have a 20-8 match record. They captured the 500 level titles in Dubai in late February (d. Klaasen/Marach) and in Hamburg (d. Dodig/Pavic) last month.
- They are No. 6 in the ATP Doubles Team Rankings and they are trying to qualify for the Nitto ATP Finals in London.
- Peers is ranked No. 28 (Career-high No. 2) and he is 22-12 in career finals. He's won at least one ATP Tour title the past eight years.
- Venus is ranked No. 10 (Career-high No. 8) and he is 12-14 in career finals. He's won at least one ATP Tour title the past six years.
