PEGULA QUICK HITS:

- Peaked at World No.1 in the WTA doubles rankings in 2023, and has won seven career doubles titles on the Hologic WTA Tour (including 3 WTA 1000 titles, all with Coco Gauff)
- Reached first Grand Slam final in women's doubles at 2022 Roland Garros (w/Gauff; I. Garcia/Mladenovic)
- Finished runner-up in mixed doubles at the 2023 US Open (w/Austin Krajicek; I. Danilina/Heliovaara); she and Krajicek also made the 2021 US Open mixed doubles SF
- Went 4-0 in mixed doubles (3 wins with Fritz and 1 with Tiafoe) during Team USA's title run at inaugural United Cup in 2023
- In singles, peaked at career-high ranking of No.3 and has won 9 WTA titles; made her first Grand Slam singles final at last year's US Open (l. Sabalenka)



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DRAPER QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his first professional tournament in mixed doubles and second Grand Slam in doubles after receiving WC to men's doubles at 2019 Wimbledon (w/Jubb), losing to Cabal/Farah.
- Originally paired with Zheng Qinwen (withdrew due to wrist injury) and Paula Badosa (withdrew due to back injury), he repaired with Pegula after withdrawal of her doubles partner Paul.
- He is 2-1 in doubles this year, advancing to 2R of ATP Masters 1000 events in Indian Wells and Monte-Carlo (w/Machac) and 29-9 in singles, highlighted by ATP Masters 1000 Indian Wells title.
- Playing in his first event since Wimbledon after withdrawing from summer hard court events due to arm injury.
- Last year in US Open singles, did not drop a set en route to his 1st Grand Slam SF, becoming fourth British men's semi-finalist in Open Era of this event.

RADUCANU QUICK HITS:

- Making her mixed doubles debut
- Has competed in WTA level doubles on three occasions including twice this year; she reached SF at Washington DC with Elena Rybakina (l. eventual champions Townsend/Zhang) and made quarterfinal at Queen's, London with Katie Boulter (l. L.Kichenok/Routliffe)
- As an 18-year-old qualifier with a ranking of No.150, won the 2021 US Open singles title without dropping a set (d. Fernandez in F)
- Reached her first WTA 500 singles SF at Washington DC this year (l. Kalinskaya)
- Is currently the British No.1 in singles



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ALCARAZ QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his first Grand Slam mixed doubles event and teamed up with Raducanu in only pairing of Grand Slam singles champions in the field.
- Went 0-2 in 2023 Hopman Cup exhibition in mixed doubles (w/Masarova).
- In men's doubles, partnered with Rafael Nadal to advance to Paris Olympics QF in July last year and is playing in first doubles match since partnering w/Granollers in 2024 Davis Cup Finals (went 1-1 W-L).
- In 2022, became second teenager to win US Open men's singles title in Open Era at age 19, following Sampras, 19, 1990.
- Went on to win his first 5 Grand Slam singles finals, lifting titles at back-to-back titles Wimbledon in 2023 and 2024 and Roland Garros in 2024 and 2025.
- Became the youngest man to win Grand Slam singles titles on all three surfaces.
- Also in singles, leads the ATP Tour in wins (53) and titles (5) this season*, including saving 3 championship points to capture Roland Garros men's singles title.

DANILOVIC QUICK HITS:

- Her only previous mixed doubles appearance was with Novak Djokovic at 2024 United Cup; the pair went 2-0 against China (d. Zhang Zhizhen and Zheng Qinwen) and the Czech Republic (d. Miriam Skoch and Petr Nouza)
- Owns two women's two doubles titles: 2022 Lausanne with Kristina Mladenovic (d. Eikeri/Zidansek in F); 2018 Tashkent alongside Tamara Zidansek (d. Begu/Olaru in F)
- Broke into the Top 100 in doubles for this first time this month
- Her best singles result at the US Open was 2r in 2021 (l. Osaka)
- Owns two WTA 250 singles titles, one on hard court: 2024 Guangzhou (d. Dolehide in F)



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DJOKOVIC QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his second Grand Slam mixed doubles draw after reaching 2006 Australian Open 2R (w/Ana Ivanovic).
- Also reached SF of Tokyo Olympics (w/Stojanovic) and went 2-0 in United Cup w/Danilovic last year.
- Last entered men's doubles at Grand Slam at 2007 Australian Open (w/Tipsarevic) and advanced to 2006 Wimbledon 2R (w/Bracciali) for his only Grand Slam men's doubles win.
- Partnered w/Erich to win lone ATP Tour doubles title at 2010 London/Queen's Club and reached finals of 2007 Adelaide (w/Stepanek) and 2021 Mallorca (w/Gomez-Herrera).
- Owns all-time men's records for most Grand Slam singles titles (24) and match wins (392), as well as most weeks at No. 1 (428) in PIF ATP Rankings history and most years ended at No. 1 (8).
- Won Geneva this year for his 100th tour-level title in singles (one of 3 men in Open Era to achieve the feat).
- He is a 10-time Australian Open champion, 7-time Wimbledon champion, 4-time US Open champion and 3-time Roland Garros champion, including winning 4 straight Grand Slam titles from 2015 Wimbledon-2016 Roland Garros.

- Won first two WTA doubles titles this year at WTA 1000 Miami and WTA 500 Brisbane both with Diana Shnaider
- Earned silver medal at 2024 Paris Olympics in women's doubles (w/Shnaider; l. in gold-medal final to Errani/Paolini)
- Reached two Grand Slam semifinals in women's doubles in 2025 (w/Shnaider at Australian Open and Roland Garros; l. to eventual champions on both occasions)
- Lost in 1r of mixed doubles event at 2024 Paris Olympics (w/Medvedev, l. Errani/Vavassori)
- In singles this year, made her Top 10 debut in February and is currently at a career-high ranking of No.5, winning two WTA 1000 titles at Dubai and Indian Wells



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MEDVEDEV QUICK HITS:

- Making his Grand Slam mixed doubles debut and plays in his second event w/M. Andreeva after losing in 1R of 2024 Paris Olympics (l. to Errani/Vavassori).
- Competed in Grand Slam men's doubles event twice in career: 2017 Roland Garros (w/Cerretani, l. to Cabal/Farah in 1R) and 2017 US Open (w/Elgin, l. to Kontinen/Peers in 2R).
- Reached 1 ATP Tour SF in doubles, at 2016 Moscow (w/Rublev) and advanced to boys' doubles QFs at 2014 Australian Open w/Safiullin and 2014 Roland Garros w/Khachanov.
- One of 8 former US Open singles champions in the draw (also Alcaraz, Djokovic, Osaka, Raducanu, Sinner, Swiatek, V. Williams).
- He is 26-17 in singles this year, including run to Halle final and 0-1 in doubles, losing in Halle 1R (w/Rublev).

- Has a 6-1 mixed doubles record at the United Cup, where she has led Team Poland to two finals (2024-25)
- In mixed doubles at Grand Slams, has played Australian Open three times (2019-21, all w/Lukasz Kubot) and reached QF in 2020; she and Kubot also made the mixed doubles QF at the Tokyo Olympics in 2021
- Career-best Grand Slam result in women's doubles is runner-up at 2021 Roland Garros (w/Mattek-Sands; I. Krejčíková/Siniakova); also made 2020 Roland Garros SF (w/Melichar-Martinez)
- In singles, has spent 125 weeks in her career ranked World No.1; she has won six Grand Slam singles titles including earlier this year at Wimbledon



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RUUD QUICK HITS:

- Partnered with countrywoman Eikeri in all previous mixed doubles matches at United Cup in 2023 and 2024, including loss to Team Poland (Swiatek/Hurkacz) in Group B earlier this season.
- First time playing mixed doubles at Grand Slam event, while he went on runs to 2021 Wimbledon QF (w/Goransson) and 2019 US Open 3R (w/Kecmanovic)
- In singles, peaked at No. 2 in 2022 and advanced to Grand Slam finals at 2022 Roland Garros (l. to Nadal), 2022 US Open (l. to Alcaraz) and 2023 Roland Garros (l. to Djokovic).
- He is 28-10 in singles this season, highlighted by biggest title of career at ATP Masters 1000 Madrid in May and 0-3 in doubles, losing in Davis Cup for Norway (w/Durasovic) and in 1R of Toronto and Cincinnati (w/Martinez).

- In 2022, reached SF of Roland Garros in women's doubles alongside Taylor Townsend (l. Coco Gauff/Jessica Pegula) and SF of Toronto women's doubles with Sania Mirza (l. eventual champions Gauff/Pegula)
- In singles, she claimed her maiden Grand Slam title this year at the Australian Open (d. Sabalenka in F) and made the US Open singles final in 2017 (l. Stephens)
- Owns ten career singles titles, with five of those on hard court: 2025 Australian Open; 2025 Adelaide; 2022 Adelaide [250]; 2019 Cincinnati; 2017 Stanford



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TIAFOE QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his first mixed doubles match since teaming up with Pegula at 2023 United Cup (d. Siegemund/Altmaier).
- Making first Grand Slam mixed doubles appearance since advancing to 2019 Wimbledon 2R (w/V. Williams) and third at US Open after 2015 (2R w/Vickery), 2016 (1R w/Vickery) and 2018 (1R w/Osuigwe).
- Reached 1 ATP Tour final at 2017 Houston (w/D. Brown).
- At US Open, advanced to 4R in men's singles every year since 2020, including 2022, 2024 SF and 2023 QF, including win over No. 3 Nadal in 2022 4R en route to becoming 1st American men's semi-finalist at US Open since 2006.
- Owns 3 career titles, at 2018 Delray Beach, 2023 Houston and 2023 Stuttgart and is the only active American male player to win ATP Tour titles on all three surfaces.

- Her lone Tour-level match win in women's doubles came at 2016 Roland Garros (w/Doi, d. Arcangioli/Paquet in 1r; I. Klepac/Srebotnik in 2r)
- Is a 4-time Grand Slam singles champion, winning hard court majors twice at the US Open (2018 and 2020) and twice at the Australian Open (2019 and 2021)
- Has spent 25 weeks ranked World No.1 in the PIF WTA Singles Rankings
- This year, made Hologic WTA Tour singles finals at Auckland and Montreal – her first tour-level finals since returning from maternity leave at the start of 2024; she also won a WTA 125-level title at 2025 Saint-Malo



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MONFILS QUICK HITS:

- Making his fifth Grand Slam mixed doubles appearance, first since advancing to 2008 Roland Garros 2R w/Cibulkova.
- Owns 2-14 men's doubles record at Grand Slams, reaching 2R at 2007 and 2010 Roland Garros, both w/Ouanna and reached 2 ATP Tour SFs in doubles, at 2010 Montpellier w/Ouanna and 2018 Quito w/Descloix.
- Frenchman, who turns 39 in two weeks, is a 13-time ATP Tour singles champion, including Auckland title in January this year to become the oldest men's tour-level champion since 1977.
- He will be making his 68th Grand Slam main draw singles appearance next week, 17th at US Open.
- Reached 10 Grand Slam QFs, including going on to reach SF at 2008 Roland Garros and 2016 US Open.

- Two-time runner-up in the US Open women's doubles: 2021 with Coco Gauff (l. Stosur/Zhang in F) and 2022 with Taylor Townsend (l. Krejčíková/Siniakova in F)
- Owns eight WTA doubles titles, most recently won 2024 Cluj-Napoca with Asia Muhammad (d. Dart/Mihalikova in F)
- Her best singles result at the US Open was 3r in 2020 (l. Mertens)



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MUSETTI QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his first Grand Slam mixed doubles event after going 1-1 at 2023 United Cup for Team Italy w/Rosatello.
- He is 0-4 in men's doubles at Grand Slam level, losing to Kokkinakis/Kyrgios at 2022 US Open w/Gaston in only previous doubles appearance at this event.
- Broke into Top 100 of PIF ATP Doubles Rankings on August 18 after reaching ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati final last week w/Sonego for his latest of 2 ATP Tour doubles finals (also 2024 Doha w/Sonego).
- In singles, broke into Top 10 this year, advanced to Grand Slam semi-finals at 2023 Wimbledon and 2024 Roland Garros, and won titles at 2022 Hamburg & 2022 Naples.
- Also won bronze medal at Paris Olympics in men's singles last year, joining Djokovic and Alcaraz on the podium, becoming first player to win an Olympic medal for Italy in singles in Open Era.

- Has made four Grand Slam mixed doubles appearances in her career, fell in the 1r on each appearance (2023 US Open w/Harrison; 2019 US Open w/Monroe; 2019 Australian Open w/Venus; 2018 US Open w/Fawcett)
- Owns one WTA doubles title; 2023 Charleston with Krawczyk (d. Olmos/Shibahara in F)
- Reached the women's doubles SF at 2022 Wimbledon with Krawczyk (l. Mertens/Zhang)
- Her best singles result at the US Open was 4r in 2022 (l. Sabalenka), also reached the singles final at 2022 Australian Open (l. Barty)



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HARRISON QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his fourth US Open mixed doubles event after losing in 1R in 2015 (w/Duval) and 2017 (w/Anisimova), before advancing to 2018 SF (w/McHale)
- Entered the draw after withdrawal of team Siniakova/Sinner
- Teamed up with Melichar-Martinez this season, advancing to 2R of Roland Garros and losing in Wimbledon 1R
- Ranked No. 108 on PIF ATP Doubles Rankings on 19 August last year, he re-entered into Top 100 in October, Top 50 in March and Top 20 in May and earned 32 of 45 career tour-level men's doubles wins in 2025
- Teamed up with Evan King to win 2 ATP Tour titles at 2025 Dallas and 2025 Acapulco, both as Q. Also reached ATP Tour finals at 2021 Delray Beach w/R. Harrison, 2025 Auckland w/R. Ram and 2025 Delray Beach w/E. King
- His older brother, Ryan, won 2017 Roland Garros men's doubles title w/Michael Venus.
